SGM Delia Quintero assumed duty as the 9th Inspector General Sergeant Major on June 12, 2023.

SGM Quintero entered the United States Army on 21 April 1992. Her basic training was at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and her advanced individual training was at Fort Gordon, Georgia, where she was awarded the Military Occupational Specialty 25L, Wire Systems Installer and Maintainer.

She has served in many assignments and positions ranging from Team Leader to Command Sergeant Major. Her most recent assignments and positions include the Command Sergeant Major of the Cyber Center of Excellence and Fort Gordon, Fort Gordon, GA; the NORAD and USNORTHCOM J-6 Senior Enlisted Leader (SEL) and the Army Element SEL, Peterson AFB, Colorado Springs, CO; the G-3/5/7 Operations SGM, HQs 311th Signal Command (Theater), Fort Shafter, HI; Brigade CSM, 516th Signal Brigade, Fort Shafter,
